Horses can sleep both lying down and standing up. Horses can run shortly after birth.

Domestic horses have a life span of around 25 years. A 19th century named "Old Billy" is said to have lived to be 62 years old.

Horses have around 205 bones in their skeleton.

Horses have been domesticated for over 5,000 years. Horses are herbivores (plant eating).

Horses have bigger eyes than any other mammal that lives on land.
