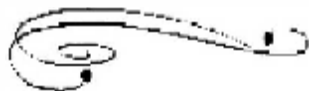

#### **SOME FUN HORSE FACTS**

Horses can sleep both lying down and standing up.  
Horses can run shortly after birth.  
Domestic horses have a life span of around 25 years. A 19th century named "Old Billy" is said to have lived to be 62 years old.  
Horses have around 205 bones in their skeleton.  
Horses have been domesticated for over 5,000 years.  
Horses are herbivores (plant eating).  
Horses have bigger eyes than any other mammal that lives on land.  
Because horse's eyes are on the side of their head they are capable of seeing nearly 360 degrees at one time.  
Horses gallop at around 27 miles per hour.  
The fastest recorded sprinted speed of a horse was 55 mph.  
Estimates suggest that there are around 55 million horses in the world.  
The tallest horse ever measured was 21.25 hands.
